The internship runs from June 5 – July 30, 2022. BioZyme will accommodate all travel, food and hotel expenses during travel.

ACCOUNTABILITIES

- The intern will work closely with the Marketing Brand Coordinator Livestock Division.
- Assist with the preparation and execution of Sure Champ, Vita Charge and VitaFerm promotion, youth outreach activities and education at ALL summer junior livestock shows attended. (see above)
- Pack and unpack booth supplies and materials.
- Conduct booth set-up on-site and work the booth during the event.
- Complete public relations and social media promotional responsibilities as needed.
- Perform post-event customer follow-up and event evaluation
- Submit a final evaluation of the internship and written expose to the Marketing Brand Coordinator Beef/Show.

QUALIFICATIONS

- College student who has completed at least two years of undergraduate studies in the areas of agriculture, animal sciences, ag business, marketing or public relations.
- A working knowledge of the show livestock industry is preferred, but not required.
- STRONG willingness to travel and spend time on the road and in hotels.
